- The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Service (CMS) provide incremental reimbursement (TPT payment) for new technologies that provide CMS beneficiaries with a substantial clinical improvement over currently available treatments
- SpineJack system is 1 of only 3 orthopaedic devices that have received transitional pass-through payment status since 2016²
- Hospitals purchasing the SpineJack system may not be realizing the full benefit of TPT payment and need reimbursement education
